A Resolution furthering annexation to the City of Sherwood of the territory described as follows:

WHEREAS, the annexation of the territory to the City has been initiated by landowners' statements of consent, in accordance with ORS 222.170, and would therefore constitute a so-called "triple majority" annexation under ORS 222.170 and a "minor boundary change" under the boundary commission law, ORS 199.410 to 199.510;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHERWOOD, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, at a regular session held on the 11th day of March, 1981 that:

> Section 1. The Council hereby approves the proposed annexation and requests the Commission to approve it and effect it as soon as possible.

Section 2. The City Recorder is hereby directed to file certified copies of the statements of consent and of this Resolution with the Portland Metropolitan Area Local Government Boundary Commission at once.
