RESOLUTION 253

WHEREAS, on June 23, 1982, the Sherwood City Council adopted Resolution 235 adopting the 1982-83 Budget, Levying Taxes in the Aggregate amount of \$217,129 and making appropriations, and

WHEREAS, it appears that pursuant to Article XI, Sect. 11 of the Oregon Constitution, said levy should be reduced by \$239.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, the City Council hereby levies taxes in an aggregate amount of \$216,890 and that these taxes are hereby levied upon all taxable property within the City of Sherwood as of 1 a.m., January 1, 1983, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that General Fund Appropriations beginning July 1, 1982 be amended as follows:


