WHEREAS City of Sherwood Ordinance No. 664 designates the City Council as the Local Contract Review Board and authorizes the City Council to exempt certain contracts from competitive bidding if the Council by unanimous vote determines that emergency conditions require prompt execution of the Contract, and


WHEREAS, due to the nature and extent of repairs and related costs of repair of the City's 1 Ton Truck required to return it to useful service to the Public Works Department, and

WHEREAS, the City requires a 1 Ton Truck for immediate and pressing construction and repair work;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that an emergency condition exists requiring the prompt execution of a contract for the purchase of a 1 Ton Truck, and


the City Administrator is hereby authorized pursuant to Ordinance No. 664 and this Resolution to enter into a contract for purchase of a 1 Ton Truck.
