RESOLUTION NO. 284

A RESOLUTION OF THE SHERWOOD CITY COUNCIL DECLARING THAT THE CITY LIBRARY BE AUTHORIZED TO SELL UNUSABLE LIBRARY BOOKS.

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood has surplus books which are no longer needed for city library operations, (which items are more particularly described on Exhibit A hereto;) and

WHEREAS, the Friends of the City Library are conducting a book sale to raise funds for city library;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

a) The books described on Exhibit A are declared no longer necessary and useful for city library purposes.

b) It is hereby ordered that same be sold to the Friends of the City Library for the sum of \$25.00.


Said sale has been found by the Council to be the most cost effective method of disposing of said books.
