RESOLUTION CANVASSING RETURNS OF REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION,  
PROCLAIMING RESULTS AND DIRECTING RECORDER TO ENTER ELECTION  
RESULTS IN THE RECORD.

WHEREAS, there has been duly and regularly certified to the  
City by the Washington County Clerk, the following returns of the  
election held in the City of Sherwood on June 26, 1984, whereat  
there was submitted to the electors the question of a two year  
serial levy for police services, a two year serial levy for park  
maintenance, and a two year serial levy for street repair and  
lighting.

No	302


Approving a two year serial levy for street repair and lighting:
