RESOLUTION NO. 87-369

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE SHERWOOD ROBIN HOOD FESTIVAL, AND THE SHERWOOD CHRISTMAS PARADE, OFFICIAL CITY SPONSORED EVENTS; FORMING A FESTIVAL COORDINATING COMMITTEE; AND ESTABLISHING BOTH AN EFFECTIVE AND SUNSETTING DATE.

WHEREAS, the annual Sherwood Robin Hood Festival has been staged almost continuously since 1948, and is the community's premier promotional and civic event; and

WHEREAS, in 1986, the Sherwood Robin Hood Festival Association, Inc., a non-profit organization, was unable to hold the Festival, due to the limited availability and high cost of insurance; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the Festival is an indispensable part of the community, and therefore is a bona-fide function of City government; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. City Responsibilities. That the annual Sherwood Robin Hood Festival and Christmas Parade are declared official City events and programs.

Section 2. Budget Authorized. That the FY 87-88 City budget shall account for applicable revenues and expenses of staging the Festival and associated events, including contributions that may be received through fundraisers, from the Festival Association, or from the community.


Section 3. Committee Appointed. That a nine member Festival Advisory Committee is hereby formed, and assigned the responsibility of promoting and staging the Festival, such Committee to be appointed by the Council, and to consist of at least one member of the Council, one member of the Parks Advisory Board, one member of the City Administration, and the President of the Festival Association. The remaining five members may be drawn from any interested parties in the community, and membership is not limited to individuals living within the city limits.

Section 4. Insurance. That the Festival, and associated events, shall be covered under City liability insurance policies, provided however, that neither City insurance, nor City responsibilities as contemplated under Section 2 and 3, shall apply to fundraisers and other similar activities sponsored by the Festival Association and conducted for the purposes of raising contributions toward defraying Festival operating costs.

Section 5. Association Responsibilities. The Sherwood Robin Hood Festival Association, Inc. shall continue to serve as a private non-profit entity dedicated to the financing, promotion and staging of Festival events, and for organizing the many and diverse volunteer efforts needed to support the Festival.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective upon Approval and Adoption by the City Council, and shall automatically expire on December 31, 1987.
