WHEREAS, a need exists to transfer appropriations totaling \$2,000.00 from the Personal Services category to the Materials and Services category within the Building Inspection Department of the General Fund, and

WHEREAS, a need exists to transfer appropriations totaling \$500.00 from the Capital Outlay category to the Transfer to Equipment Rental Fund category within the Water Fund, and

WHEREAS, a need exists to transfer appropriations totaling \$500.00 from the Materials and Services category to the Personal Services category within the Street Fund, and

WHEREAS, a need exists to transfer appropriations totaling \$2,129.00 from the Contingency category to the Personal Services category; and \$1,234 from the Materials and Services category with \$500.00 being transferred to the Transfer to Other Funds category and \$734.00 being transferred to the Personal Services category within the Storm Drainage Fund, and

WHEREAS, a need exists to transfer appropriations totaling \$4,300.00 from the Contingency category to the Materials and Services category within the Bancroft Redemption Fund, and

WHEREAS, a need exists to transfer appropriations totaling \$500.00 from the Contingency category to the Capital Outlay category within the Federal Revenue Sharing Fund, and

WHEREAS, the need for these increased expenditures was not anticipated with the original budget was adopted.
