A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE STOP-SIGNING OF MAIN STREET AT ITS INTERSECTION AT FIRST STREET, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, having heard and considered the recommendation of the Police Chief relative to the signing at the intersection of Main Street and First Street in the City of Sherwood;


WHEREAS, having heard and considered the testimony of adjacent property owners and residents regarding the unsafe conditions created by the current pattern of signing at the Main and First intersection;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section: 1. Intersection. Main Street at its intersection with First Street is hereby made a stop street and shall be signed as such on the northwesterly and southeasterly corners. First Street at its intersection with Main Street shall remain a stop street.

Section: 2. Change Authorized: The City Manager is directed to cause standard traffic signs to be installed as necessary to carry out the foregoing provisions.

Section: 3. Effective Date: This Resolution shall become effective upon approval and adoption.
