A RESOLUTION ADVISING THE LEGISLATIVE TASK FORCE ON METROPOLITAN REGIONAL GOVERNMENT OF THE POSITION OF THE CITY OF SHERWOOD PERTAINING TO THE STRUCTURE AND GOVERNANCE OF THE METROPOLITAN SERVICE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood is within the boundaries of the Metropolitan Service District, and therefore a recipient of the services offered by METRO, and a contributor to METRO's finances.

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood understands that the Legislative Task Force on Metropolitan Regional Government is considering the expansion of METRO's powers, and changes in this regional governments governing structure.

WHEREAS, METRO recently acquired an additional authority of regional significance, that being the convention center project.

WHEREAS, the City wishes to make its position on this important matter known to the Task Force.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- METRO's Authority. That METRO's authority Section: 1. be limited to its current functions: the Washington Zoo, Regional Transportation Park Planning, Regional Solid Waste Planning and Operations, Intergovernmental Assistance, Administration of the Urban Growth Boundary, Regional Data and Population Forecasting, and the Convention Center, and that METRO's powers be expanded to include other municipal services involving more than one jurisdiction when invited by these jurisdictions.
- <u>Section:</u> 2. <u>METRO's Structure</u>. That the Task Force give serious consideration to replacing the elected executive position with an appointed position; and that the number of elected METRO Councilors not be expanded to a greater number.
