RESOLUTION NO. 88-410

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING STOP-SIGNING AT THE INTERSECTION OF HALL STREET AND WILLAMETTE STREET, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, having heard and considered the recommendation of the Police Chief relative to the signing at the intersection of Hall Street and Willamette Street in the City of Sherwood; and

WHEREAS, having heard and considered the petition of local residents regarding the unsafe conditions created by the current pattern of signing at the Hall and Willamette Street intersection; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Hall Street at its intersection with Willamette Street shall remain a stop street and is signed as such on the North-westerly corner.

Section 2. Willamette Street at its intersection with Hall Street is hereby made a stop street in both directions and shall be signed as such on the south-westerly and north-easterly corners.

Section 3. The City Manager is directed to cause standard traffic signs to be installed and removed as necessary to carry out the foregoing provisions.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.

We the undersigned residents on Willamette and Hall Street would like to point out a traffic problem that exists on our streets. Traffic has increased in this area to the point that it is often difficult for us to get out of our driveways, especially the Grans and the Graffs. Cars are proceeding at excessive speed in this area.

In the past, we have discussed this problem with the Sherwood police. It is true they cannot sit in this area day and night to monitor the traffic flow. An equitable solution to the problem would be to install stop signs on Willamette at the corner of Willamette and Hall. Such a stop sign did exist at one time and we believe it did alleviate some of the problems; why it was removed is a mystery to us.

We would appreciate your consideration in this matter. We would greatly appreciate stop signs at Hall Street on East and West Willamette. Thank you for your immediate attention.
