RESOLUTION REGARDING MEMBERSHIP IN THE CITY/COUNTY INSURANCE SERVICES TRUST

Whereas, the City/County Insurance Services Trust (CIS) offers pooled self-insurance offering cost stability and the potential for long-term savings; and

Whereas, CIS is sponsored by the League of Oregon Cities and the Association of Oregon Counties as a service to Oregon cities and counties; and

Whereas, the City of Sherwood finds that membership in CIS is of benefit in managing the risks involved in providing services to its citizens; and

Whereas, the City of Sherwood has been provided with an opportunity to review the Trust Agreement, Bylaws and Rules of CIS; and


Whereas, the City of Sherwood has submitted the Trust Agreement, Bylaws and Rules of CIS to its legal counsel to review for compliance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Sherwood;

Now, therefore, the City of Sherwood does hereby enter into a contract with CIS and becomes a member of the CIS Trust for General Liability and Automobile Liability for a three-year period commencing July 1, 1988 and agrees to abide by the terms of the Trust Agreement, Bylaws and Rules of CIS which, along with this Resolution, constitutes the contract between the City of Sherwood and CIS. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute such documents as are necessary pursuant to this Resolution.
