A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A CITY POLICY TO BUY PRODUCTS MADE IN AMERICA AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, imports are impacting the American economy; and

WHEREAS, it is in our best interests to sustain manufacturing capabilities at home and thereby retain the the economic benefit; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood can contribute to the health of the American economy by buying products made in America; and

WHEREAS, the City also recognizes that it may not always be practical or in the best interests of City taxpayers to "Buy American" due to the price, quality, or availability of particular products.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: That when goods and products made in America are at least equal in price, quality, and availability to other products, the City of Sherwood shall give preference to American goods in awarding procurement contracts and making purchase.

Section 2: Effective Date: This Resolution shall become effective upon approval and adoption.
