A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE STOP-SIGNING OF WEST DIVISION STREET AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH S.W. WASHINGTON STREET, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, having heard and considered the recommendation of the Police Chief relative to the signing at the intersection of Division Street and Washington Street in the City of Sherwood;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Intersection: West Division Street at its intersection with S.W. Washington Street is hereby made a stop street and shall be signed as such on the northeasterly corner. A right turn without stopping shall be allowed from Division Street to Washington Street heading Northbound and shall be signed as such on the northeasterly corner.

Section 2: Change Authorized: The City Manager is directed to cause standard traffic signs to be installed as necessary to carry out the foregoing provisions.

Section 3: Effective Date: This Resolution shall become effective upon approval and adoption.

The sign should allow a free right turn at all times to proceed north on Washington. The stop sign would cause motorists to stop before proceeding west on Division. It should also inform the motorist to yield to the uphill or southbound traffic on Washington Street.
