A RESOLUTION VALIDATING THE CITY OF SHERWOOD'S EMERGENCY CONTRACT WITH J.W. FOWLER COMPANY TO COMPLETE THE BULL-RUN CONNECTION TIE-IN TO TUALATIN.

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood staff awarded a contract to complete the Bull-Run connection tie-in to Tualatin on an emergency basis to J.W. Fowler Company before the meeting of the city council; and,

WHEREAS, the contract is necessary because the original contractor was unable to perform the work and the Bull-Run line is needed to meet peak water usage in the Summer; and,

WHEREAS, the amount of the contract was for \$16,550 to complete the tie-in.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Validation. The City of Sherwood staff acted on an emergency basis to ensure the completion of the Bull-Run tie-in and to prevent an interruption of water service to Sherwood residents. The city council hereby ratifies, confirms, and approves the award of the contract to J.W. Fowler Company to complete the bull-run tie-in to Tualatin.

<u>Section 2. Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
