A RESOLUTION VALIDATING THE CITY OF SHERWOOD'S EMERGENCY CONTRACT WITH SCHNEIDER EQUIPMENT IN ORDER TO COMMENCE WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood staff awarded a contract to commence the City's Water System Improvements on an emergency basis to Schneider Equipment before the meeting of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, improvements include waterline replacement, reservoir pumps, site buildings at both existing reservoirs and Well #6 locations and upgrade of telemetry system; and

WHEREAS, the contract is necessary in order to meet the water usage needs of all residents in Sherwood; and.

WHEREAS, Schneider Equipment, St. Paul, Oregon submitted the low bid for the project in the amount of \$594,081.51, which consists of all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to complete the work described in the Base Bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 Validation: The City of Sherwood staff acted on an emergency basis to ensure the earliest possible construction upon the City's Water System Improvements in order meet present and future water usage demands. The City Council hereby ratifies, confirms, and approves the award of the contract to Schneider Equipment, St. Paul, Oregon, in an amount not to exceed \$650,000.00.
