A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE "DOG CONTROL AGREEMENT" WITH WASHINGTON COUNTY TO ALLOW THE COUNTY TO CITE VIOLATORS INTO THE JUSTICE COURT AND TO REVISE WASHINGTON COUNTY CODE REFERENCES.

WHEREAS, Washington County and the City of Sherwood maintain a Dog Control Agreement in which the County has agreed to enforce a dog control program within the City of Sherwood pursuant to County Ordinance 306 and amendments; and
