A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SHERWOOD TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE OREGON STATE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT IN ORDER TO OBTAIN FEDERAL LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUNDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A SPORTS COURT LIGHTING SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior made funds available through the Oregon State Parks and Recreation Department (herein called the Department) to disperse funds to worthy recreational projects, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood applied for and has been offered a matching grant from the Department with the intent of purchasing and installing lights around the sports court facility located between Hopkins Elementary and Sherwood Middle School on South Sherwood Boulevard, and;


WHEREAS, in order to secure the funds for the sports court lighting system, the Department requires Sherwood City Council's approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Intergovernmental Agreement. The Sherwood City Council accepts the Land and Water Conservation Fund grant of \$20,000 and agrees to adhere to the rules and regulations as outlined in the Intergovernmental Agreement and associated General Provisions.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon approval and adoption.
