A RESOLUTION DECLARING SURPLUS MATERIALS TO BE SOLD AT PUBLIC AUCTION OR OTHERWISE DISPOSED OF, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City has surplus materials, supplies and property which are no longer needed for City operations, which items are more particularly described on "Exhibit A" attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, an auction of surplus government property will be held at a time and location to be determined by City staff at a future date.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Surplus: That the items described on "Exhibit A" are declared surplus and shall be sold or otherwise disposed of.

Section 2. Auction: That it is hereby ordered that the items described in Section 1 if not otherwise disposed of, may be offered for public sale, said sale be held in accordance with applicable City ordinances.

Section 3. Other Means of Disposal: If not removed at sale, the items in Section 1 shall be disposed of in accordance with applicable City ordinances.

Section 4. Effective Date: That this Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
