<u>Section 2. Auction:</u> That it is hereby ordered that the items described in Section 1 if not otherwise disposed of, may be offered for public sale, said sale be held in accordance with applicable City ordinances.

<u>Section 3. Other Means of Disposal:</u> If not removed at sale, the items in Section 1 shall be disposed of in accordance with applicable City ordinances.

<u>Section 4. Effective Date:</u> That this Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
