RESOLUTION NO. 96-632

WHEREAS, ORS 221.760 provides as follows:

Section 1. The officer responsible for disbursing funds to cities under ORS 323.455, 366.785 to 366.820 and 471.805 shall, in the case of a city located within a county having more than 100,000 inhabitants according to the most recent federal decennial census, disburse such funds only if the city provides four or more of the following services:

- (1) Police protection
- (2) Fire protection
- (3) Street construction, maintenance, and lighting
- (4) Sanitary sewer
- (5) Storm sewers
- (6) Planning, zoning, and subdivision control
- (7) One or more utility services

and

WHEREAS, city officials recognize the desirability of assisting the state officer responsible for determining the eligibility of cities to receive such funds in accordance with ORS 221.760, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Sherwood hereby certifies that it provides the following four or more municipal services enumerated in Section 1, ORS 221.760:

Police protection
Street construction, maintenance and lighting
Sanitary sewer
Storm sewer
Water services
Planning, zoning and subdivision control

The State Controller's Division is responsible for certification of eligibility of cities for state-shared revenues (cigarette, liquor and highway taxes) under ORS 221.760.

The law provides that cities located within a county having more than 100,000 inhabitants, according to the most recent decennial census (1990), must provide four or more of the following municipal services to be eligible to receive the revenues:

- Police protection,
- Fire protection,
- Street construction, maintenance, and lighting,
- Sanitary sewers,
- Storm sewers,
- Planning, zoning, & subdivision control,
- One or more utility services.

In order to gain this certification, we will need to have a Resolution from your Council which states that four or more of these services are being provided. A model resolution, applicable to your city under ORS 221.760 is enclosed for your City Council action.

Please return a copy of the Resolution to this office by July 31, 1996, to assure your city's certification. IF YOU ARE NOT CERTIFIED BY JULY 31, 1996, YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE YOUR PORTION OF THE STATE-SHARED REVENUES.

In an effort to improve efficiency and to save time and resources, Statewide Central Disbursements urges your city to join the Local Government Investment Pool at the State Treasury.

Benefits of belonging to the LGIP:

- Funds are deposited directly into your account at the State Treasury.
- Mailing time for a warrant to reach your city is eliminated.
- Interest is earned as of the day of the deposit.

Each statewide distribution must be requested separately to be deposited into the Local Government Investment Pool account for your city. Please check the appropriate box(es) below.
