A RESOLUTION AUTHORITYING STAFF TO SOLICIT A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FROM WASHINGTON COUNTY, ASSIGNING PROJECT PRIORITY, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City wishes to obtain a Community Development Block grant to add, enhance or replace certain items at the Stewart Senior-Community Center in Sherwood.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Authorization. The City Manager is hereby authorized to submit a request to the Washington County Development Block Grant office for the purpose of adding, enhancing, or replacing certain items at the Stewart Senior/Community Center in Sherwood.

Section 2. Priority. The priority of projects of the subject block grant is as follows:

1. Purchase a freezer and construct a freezer room.
2. Replace existing lighting.
3. Replace audio system.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
