**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR THE ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN OF A PARK, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, in September 1996, Sherwood residents overwhelmingly passed a \$1.5 million bond for the development of a community park; and,

**WHEREAS**, on February 25, 1998, the City Manager authorized staff to prepare a request for proposal (RFP) for the design of said public improvement; and,

**WHEREAS**, the project was advertised in the Daily Journal of Commerce on February 27, 1998 and March 2, 1998; and,

**WHEREAS**, 12 proposals were received prior to the proposal deadline, March 12, 1998; and

**WHEREAS**, proposals were reviewed and qualified applicants were interviewed on April 1, 1998, by staff and a citizen's committee.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Authorization. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Walker-Macy, Portland, Oregon for the design of a Park.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
