## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR THE ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN OF A PARK, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in September 1996, Sherwood residents overwhelmingly passed a \$1.5 million bond for the development of a community park; and,

WHEREAS, on February 25, 1998, the City Manager authorized staff to prepare a request for proposal (RFP) for the design of said public improvement; and,

WHEREAS, the project was advertised in the Daily Journal of Commerce on February 27, 1998 and March 2, 1998; and,

WHEREAS, 12 proposals were received prior to the proposal deadline, March 12, 1998; and

WHEREAS, proposals were reviewed and qualified applicants were interviewed on April 1, 1998, by staff and a citizen's committee.

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1. Authorization.</u> The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Walker-Macy, Portland, Oregon for the design of a Park.

<u>Section 2. Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
