A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE ORGAN IN THE ROBIN HOOD THEATER SURPLUS AND DIRECTING THAT IT BE SOLD BY METHOD OF SEALED BID AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council has received a recommendation from the Robin Hood Theater Steering Committee to sell the organ in the theater because it is not of high quality, would be very expensive to repair, and takes up room that could be put to use to construct a stage; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing the steering committee's recommendation the Council agrees with its conclusion and therefore wishes to declare the Wurlitzer Opus Number 2018, Special Style SCH 61 organ in the theater along with all the organ related equipment such as the pipes and blower to be surplus property no longer needed for City operations,


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Adoption: The City Council orders that the Wurlitzer Opus Number 2018 organ, Special Style SCH 61 along with all organ related equipment such as the pipes and blower be labeled as surplus and that they be sold by method of sealed bid.

Section 2. Effective Date: This resolution will become effective upon adoption.
