NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Sherwood, Oregon.


SECTION 1. The Council commends and extends its appreciation to Bill Boyle for his service to the City. He leaves Sherwood a better place for present and future citizens.


SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
