



RESOLUTION 99-792

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING MEMBERSHIP INTO THE WASHINGTON COUNTY CONSOLIDATED COMMUNICATIONS AGENCY FOR THE CITY OF BANKS; AND AUTHORIZING A LETTER OF UNDERSTANDING AND AN AMENDMENT TO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT TO FACILITATE THE NEW MEMBERSHIP.

WHEREAS, this matter came before the Sherwood City Council, acting as the governing body of the City of Sherwood, at its regular meeting of April 13, 1999; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Sherwood City Council that it is a participating jurisdiction in the Washington County Consolidated Communications Agency ("Agency"), an organization created by intergovernmental agreement ("Intergovernmental Agreement") and pursuant to ORS 190-010, for purposes of performing functions of a 9-1-1 public safety answering point and initiating appropriate response; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Sherwood City Council that the City of Banks has requested membership in the Agency; and pursuant to paragraph 9 of the Intergovernmental Agreement, increased membership in the Agency requires unanimous approval of all Agency participating jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Sherwood City Council that the Intergovernmental Agreement should be amended to facilitate the proposed increase in membership;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

The Sherwood City Council hereby approves, effective April 13, 1999, an increase in the Washington County Consolidated Communications Agency participating jurisdiction membership to include the City of Banks.
