

Resolution No. 99-808

A RESOLUTION DECLARING SURPLUS MATERIALS TO BE SOLD AT PUBLIC AUCTION OR OTHERWISE DISPOSED OF, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Police Department has submitted a request to Council to surplus its detective vehicle which is no longer needed for department operations; and

WHEREAS, the surplus vehicle is described in "Exhibit A."

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1. Adoption:</u> The City Council orders that the vehicle listed in Exhibit A become labeled as surplus and the City will offer the vehicle at a public auction to be determined by staff at a future date.

<u>Section 2. Other Means of Disposal:</u> If not sold at an auction, the vehicle listed in Exhibit A may be disposed of according to applicable state statutes.

Section 3. Effective Date: This resolution is effective upon adoption.
