A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE DEADLINE FOR THE CITY OF SHERWOOD TO RESPOND TO A PROPOSAL TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE WILLAMETTE WATER TREATMENT FACILITY, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on June 1, 1999, the City of Tigard adopted a resolution of its intention to construct a water treatment plant on the Willamette River and the associated transmission lines; and,

WHEREAS, section 5.1 of the WWSA Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement provides that there is a 90 day period of time for other WWSA members to elect to participate in the proposed project; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood is currently assessing its long-term water needs and requires additional time to review this important community issue; and,

WHEREAS, an amendment to Section 5.1 of the WWSA Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement will extend the deadline from August 31, 1999 to October 30, 1999.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City Manager Pro Tem is hereby authorized to notify the WWSA that additional time is required by the City of Sherwood and agrees to the new deadline of October 30, 1999, in order to elect whether or not to participate in the proposed project (water treatment plant on the Willamette River).

Section 2: This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
