

Resolution No. 99-826

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING STAFF TO ENTER INTO NEGOTIATIONS FOR REAL PROPERTY FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND LIBRARY.

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood recognizes that the present Police Department and Library facilities are not large enough to house staff and resources for optimum service to the citizens; and

WHEREAS, there are presently properties available within the Sherwood City limits which potentially could meet the need for larger facilities for the Police Department and Library; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to proceed at the earliest possible time to acquire property for these facilities.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1. Authorization.</u> The staff is hereby authorized to enter into negotiations for real property for the Police Department and Library.

Section 2. <u>Council Directive</u>. The staff will come before Council to present the details of their negotiations and to request authorization for the amount needed to make the property purchase(s).

Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
