

Resolution No. 99-838

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO RELEASE FUNDS TO THE ROBIN HOOD FESTIVAL ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood budgeted to support City celebrations during the current fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, it is the City's expectation that a like amount will be committed to the City celebration fund for fiscal year 2000/2001, and

WHEREAS, the Robin Hood Association volunteer members have pledged to raise \$7,000 for the year 2000 Old Town Celebration, and

WHEREAS, the Robin Hood Association has provided a detailed breakdown of their anticipated expenses for the 2000 Old Town Celebration, which is listed as Exhibit A to this document; and

WHEREAS, the City has, in the past always provided financial support to help fund this City celebration,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Manager and City Finance Director are hereby authorized to issue funds to the Robin Hood Festival Association for actual expenses, based upon presentation of paid receipts, not to exceed a sum of \$14,650.00 which is the amount requested.

Section 2: This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
