



Resolution No. 2000-847

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE A ONE-TON TRUCK FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the needs for such a vehicle have grown with the increase in the number of Public Works projects and maintenance activities; and

WHEREAS, the present truck is being transferred to the Parks Department; and

WHEREAS, the City and its Public Works Department need to continue the program of equipment additions and replacements to keep pace with and anticipate system and facility demands; and

WHEREAS, the City has the opportunity to participate in the State Purchasing Program, which enables the City to achieve cost and schedule advantages.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase a one-ton truck at a cost of no more than \$28,000.

Section 2: This resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
