



Resolution No. 2000-864

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PARKS TO UTILITZE FUNDS FROM THE PARKS BOND FUND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SNYDER PARK, AND TO SUBMIT APPLICATION MATERIALS STATING THIS FACT TO THE ORPD LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood City Council, after careful review and public support, authorized the Park Development Coordinator in February 2000 to move forward with the development of Snyder Park, and;

WHEREAS, the residents of the City of Sherwood appropriated funds for the development of athletic fields with the passage of the YMCA/Parks Bond of 1996, and;

WHEREAS, a consultant was hired to work with the Park Development Coordinator, the Parks Advisory Board, and the citizens of our community to devise a Master Plan for the Snyder Park, and;

WHEREAS, the planning process for Snyder Park has insured the opportunity for all citizens to be involved in all phases of the park design and master planning process, and;

WHEREAS, Snyder Park is a component of the City of Sherwood/Sherwood School District joint recreational facilities plan, and is a component of the Sherwood Parks, Recreation and Open Space Master Plan Update 2000.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Sherwood City Council authorizes the use of Park Bond funds for the development of Snyder Park, and directs the Director of Parks to use these funds in a fiscally responsible manner.

Section 2. The Sherwood City Council authorizes the Director of Parks to utilize this, and any, funding information in the application process for the OPRD Local Government Grant Program.
