## Resolution No. 2000-893

## A RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE FUNDING REQUEST FROM ODOT-REGION 1 FOR THE SHERWOOD ACCESS MANAGEMENT BONDING PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) and the City of Sherwood have worked on transportation planning issues and the Transportation System Plan for the past five or more years; and

WHEREAS, the City teamed with ODOT to recently complete a trip budgeting model that the city intends to implement into its comprehensive plan and zoning ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the City is interested in controlling access on Highway 99W and preventing any additional signalized intersections in Sherwood's portion of 99W after the Meinecke-99W intersection is completed; and

WHEREAS, reconstruction of the Meinecke-99W intersection has been one of the city's highest transportation priorities since the current Transportation System Plan was adopted in 1990; and

WHEREAS, Meinecke Road is intended to serve as the primary gateway to downtown Sherwood from Highway 99W in the future; and

WHEREAS, the City is currently investing its own funds to complete a preliminary alignment study for the Meinecke-99W intersection and Meinecke gateway into Sherwood.

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. To fully endorse the Sherwood Access Management Bonding project application by ODOT-Region 1 which will provide funding for engineering

and construction of access management improvements on Highway 99W, including reconstruction of the Meinecke-99W intersection; and

<u>Section 2.</u> To contribute significant local matching funds to the reconstruction of the Meinecke-99W intersection.
