**Resolution 2000-915**

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE REPORT FROM THE 2000 PERFORMING ARTS RALLIES AND DIRECTING STAFF TO PREPARE STRATEGIES FOR IMPLEMENTING THE REPORT'S RECOMMENDATIONS**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Sherwood has declared that Sherwood is to be the home of a regional performing arts complex, and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council charted a series of public rallies to gather ideas, to build support, and to develop a series of recommendations for implementing the vision, and

**WHEREAS**, that report presents a statement of policy declaring specific directions for a performing arts center, and

**WHEREAS**, that report also presents specific recommendations for organization and structure that need analysis relative to budget and organizational issues, and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council, sitting as the Board of Directors of the Sherwood Urban Renewal Agency, on November 14, 2000 approved a preliminary budget of \$750,000 for Stage 1 improvements to the Robin Hood Theater and the Old School as the beginning of developing a Performing Arts Center.


**NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Sherwood that:**

Section 1: The report from the 2000 Performing Arts Rallies is accepted as a statement of public policy.


Section 2: The Staff is directed to analyze the specific recommendations in terms of budget and organizational issues and present a specific action plan consistent with the intent of the original recommendations.

Section 3: The Staff is directed to return to the City Council and Urban Renewal Agency Board of Directors in February 2001 to present the action plan for approval.
