



Resolution No. 2001-928

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE CITY COUNCIL'S SUPPORT FOR THE COMMUNITY ASSET BUILDING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City has been introduced to the concept of Developmental Assets by the Washington County Commission on Children and Families, and

WHEREAS, the Developmental Assets provide a framework for community decision making and action that focuses resources and results on building successful families, and

WHEREAS, the City, School District, YMCA, Senior Center, and Chamber of Commerce have begun an informal task force that is working on means to unite and use the framework of the assets to bring more successful coordinated service delivery to the community along with additional resources to assist with these efforts, and

WHEREAS, Councilor Angela Weeks as the Council's representative to youth programs along with key city staff have been actively working on this task force, and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the use of the Development Assets as a framework and focus for partnership, decision-making, and action is of significant benefit to the citizens of Sherwood,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

The Council endorses the work of the joint task force on community assets and directs the Council representatives and Staff to continue efforts to develop specific programs, based on asset building, that benefit the citizens of Sherwood.
