



Resolution No. 2001-932

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE REQUEST OF THE FRIENDS OF THE REFUGE TO UTILIZE CITY PROPERTY FOR A WETLANDS MITIGATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, The Friends of the Refuge has asked for City permission to carry out a wetlands restoration project that will include city property, and

WHEREAS, Sherwood Venture LLC is developing a business park on the north side of Tualatin-Sherwood Road; development of the property requires a wetland enhancement project; the northern portion of the site, coupled with adjacent city owned land, has been identified as an excellent site for such an enhancement project; the city property is part of a floodplain corridor owned by the city; there are no utilities within this area and there are no plans for any other use of the property; and the wetland work is consistent with the intent of the corridor, and

WHEREAS, the Friends of the Refuge is proposing to undertake this project, which will involve carrying out the enhancements and maintaining them over time, and

WHEREAS, Staff has determined that a use agreement establishing a contractual arrangement between all the parties is the most appropriate tool to form an agreement for carrying out this project,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

The City Manager is authorized to negotiate and execute an Use Agreement between the City and the Friends of the Refuge for utilization of city property for a wetlands enhancement project in cooperation with Sherwood Venture, LLC.
