## A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE STRATEGY FOR DEVELOPMENT OF THE SHERWOOD CENTER FOR THE PERFORMING AND CULTURAL ARTS

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Sherwood on December 12, 2000 adopted Resolution 2000-915, A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE REPORT FROM THE 2000 PERFORMING ARTS RALLIES AND DIRECTING STAFF TO PREPARE STRATEGIES FOR IMPLEMENTING THE REPORT'S RECOMMENDATIONS, and

WHEREAS, the City commissioned an economic study that analyzed, in part, the market available for development of a performing arts complex and how to best capture that market, and

WHEREAS, the economic study concluded that the market for a performing arts complex is strong, and Council finds that the market is sufficient enough to warrant the investment of public funds to create a center, and

WHEREAS, the City Staff has prepared a strategy for development of a performing arts center based on the professional work and community input over the last 18 months;

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Strategy for Development of the Sherwood Center for the Performing and Cultural Arts dated April 2001 is hereby adopted, and

<u>Section 2.</u> The Staff, with the assistance of the Cultural Arts Commission, is directed to carry out the Strategy.
