A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE LAND USE DECISION BY WASHINGTON COUNTY FOR DEVELOPMENT OF THE OREGON STREET RE-ALIGNMENT

Whereas, The City Council of the City of Sherwood on May 8, 2001 adopted Resolution 2001-951, A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE FINDINGS OF THE WASHINGTON COUNTY STAFF FOR DEVELOPMENT OF THE OREGON STREET RE-ALIGNMENT PROJECT, and

Whereas, the City recognizes that the flood plain standards of Washington County Community Development Code are equal to that of the Sherwood Zoning and Community Development Code; and,

Whereas, development of the Oregon Street re-alignment as approved and conditioned by Washington County will meet the performance standards of the Sherwood Zoning and Community Development Code flood plain requirements; and,


Whereas, the centerline of Oregon Street forms the boundary of the two jurisdictions, and the requirement of an additional permit is redundant and unnecessary; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The findings and conditions included in the staff report dated April 27, 2001 regarding Washington County case file #01-148-D(CI)/FP are hereby adopted, and
