

Resolution No. 2001-962

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A COUNCIL POLICY (#1) – PUBLIC CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY IN OLD TOWN SHERWOOD DURING THE THANKSGIVING THROUGH NEW YEAR HOLIDAY SEASON

WHEREAS the period of time between Thanksgiving and New Years is a critical period for retailers in Old Town Sherwood; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood supports these retailers, and wants to take appropriate action so that customers will not be disrupted or discouraged from shopping at these stores, and

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood will endeavor to schedule public projects so that they do not conflict with the Holiday season, and when they do, to stabilize the area and suspend construction activity during this period; and

WHEREAS, it is understood that emergency repairs issues may arise, e.g. the failure of a water line or other such emergency that could require immediate action be taken, and in these instances, the repairs will be made as soon as practicable, and the street/sidewalk reopened at the earliest possible time.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

Policy Statement: It is the policy of the Council of Sherwood to suspend public construction projects affecting the street/sidewalk area in any retail district between Thanksgiving and New Years each year whenever possible.
