A RESOLUTION IN THE MATTER OF ENFORCEMENT OF BASKETBALL APPARATUS OR OTHER MATERIAL IN DRIVEWAY APPROACHES

WHEREAS, local and state law prohibits either directly or indirectly the placement of basketball apparatus (hoops) or other materials in driveway approaches or aprons; and

WHEREAS, the placement of such apparatus in such location does not directly impede the use of the sidewalk or street; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood resources are limited with regard to enforcement and code compliance actions;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Due to limited resources for code enforcement and compliance, city staff is directed to enforce alleged violations with regard to placement of basketball or other play apparatus or materials in driveway aprons or approaches on a complaint only basis.
