

Resolution 2002-023

A RESOLUTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PREPARING A SUB-AREA PLANNING STUDY FOR PROPERTIES WITHIN THE HIGHWAY 99W CORRIDOR

WHEREAS, development in the Highway 99W corridor in Sherwood has been impeded by inadequate access; and,

WHEREAS, the Meinecke Road intersection project is scheduled for completion, to correct some of those deficiencies; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood seeks to accommodate a more efficient transportation system, without expanding its boundary to induce additional growth; and,

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Agreement with Oregon Department of Transportation, and funding for the Meinecke interchange project does not include funding for a sub-area study; and,

WHEREAS, Councilor Weeks has directed staff to begin the sub-area study immediately;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Planning Department staff undertake a sub-area study of properties to determine whether parcels within the corridor should be re-zoned to better utilize access and more efficiently use developable land within the Highway 99W corridor; the boundaries of the sub-area are to be proposed by staff and confirmed by the Council.

Section 2. That the study shall include an analysis of: vacant properties, and those ripe for redevelopment; the potential impacts of different densities; area circulation routes and local street functional capacities; potential scenarios for rezoning; impacts to other vacant or re-developing land within the City; analyze the availability of utilities and services to serve all potential uses; and determine if changes to the zoning districts in the study area are timely.

<u>Section 3</u>. That the study be completed before undertaking any rezone or map amendment of properties in the identified corridor.
