A RESOLUTION TO HONOR THOSE LOST ON SEPTEMBER 11, 2001 AND THOSE WHO GAVE SO MUCH OF THEMSELVES DURING THE SEPTEMBER 11, TRAGEDY IN NEW YORK.

On September 11 henceforth, all City Flags will be flown at half -staff in remembrance and out of respect for all citizens affected by September 11 tragedy.
