

## Resolution No. 2002-053

## A RESOLUTION ASSIGNING SPECIFIC COUNCIL-APPPOINTED BOARDS & COMMISSIONS OVERSIGHT FOR COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS

WHEREAS, the Sherwood City Council has appointed citizen representatives to sit on several boards and commissions that advise the Council; and

WHEREAS, as the City continues to grow, the Council is spending more and more time dealing with the fundamental business of the City's government and relying on its board and commission members to distill information related to their assigned areas of expertise and responsibility; and

WHEREAS, local community organizations would be better served by working with the boards and committees appointed by Council whose purpose is to focus on specific issues,

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Cultural Arts Commission is assigned to hear presentations from the local performing arts company, presently named as the Robin Hood Theater Association and the local historical society, presently named The Sherwood Historical Society.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Cultural Arts Commission will make presentations to Council on behalf of the interests of the two aforementioned organizations when the Cultural Arts Commission and the commission's liaison from Council concur.

Section 3. Other community organizations not named here will contact the City Recorder who will work with the Council to ensure their business is brought before the respective Board or Commission that has oversight.

Section 4. All persons or organizations requesting an appearance before SURPAC (Sherwood's Urban Renewal and Policy Advisory Committee) will contact the City Recorder who will coordinate with the SURPAC Chair and SURPAC staff liaison to prepare meeting agendas.
