



Resolution No. 2003-048

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MURRAY, SMITH & ASSOCIATES, INC. FOR THE WELL NO. 4 RECONSTRUCTION DESIGN

WHEREAS, the Well No. 4 Reconstruction project is contained in the city's Capital Improvement Plan, adopted as part of the 2002-03 budget ; and

WHEREAS, city staff utilized a consultant selection process for this project meeting the requirements of the city's and state's contract rules; and

WHEREAS, the firm Murray, Smith and Associates, Inc. was selected through this process to design this project; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated design cost is \$108,000, with an additional \$39,400 of costs possible for well and pump rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer recommends a design contingency of 10% (\$14,740) to cover unanticipated design and rehabilitation costs.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Murray, Smith and Associates, Inc. for design of the Well No. 4 Well House Reconstruction project for an amount not exceeding \$162,140.
