A RESOLUTION APPOINTING COUNCILOR DAVE GRANT AND THE SHERWOOD CULTURAL ARTS COMMISSION OVERSIGHT FOR THE OLD BLUE SCHOOLHOUSE

WHEREAS, the City owns the property at the corner of North Sherwood and Third Street known as the old blue schoolhouse; and

WHEREAS, there are presently two offers before the City from interested parties who would like to either lease or buy the old blue schoolhouse; and

WHEREAS, neither offer would fully recover what the taxpayers paid for the building.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Councilor Dave Grant and the Cultural Arts Commission are hereby appointed to evaluate the present offers and bring their recommendations before Council.


Section 2: Council will require that in the event a tenant is leasing the premises, a condition of the lease will be if the City receives a viable offer to purchase the building, the tenant will be served with a 60-day notice to vacate and the lease will be terminated.

Section 3: This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
