A RESOLUTION APPROVING STOP SIGNS AT LOWELL AND STONEHAVEN

WHEREAS, a citizen, Cindy Francois and others, requested stop signs for the intersection of Stonehaven and Lowell; and

WHEREAS, the City Council passed Resolution 2001-975 which established a policy for neighborhood traffic speed control; and

WHEREAS, the policy requires requests for traffic signs to be used for speed control to meet certain requirements; and

WHEREAS, the applicant has met these requirements by submitting petitions showing neighborhood support; and


WHEREAS, the City Engineer endorses installation stop signs at all legs of this intersection.

Section 1: Installation of stop signs at this location is approved.


Section 2: This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
