

Resolution 2003-078

A RESOLUTION SCHEDULING A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER PETITIONS REQUESTING VACATION OF A PORTION OF THE MEINECKE ROAD RIGHT OF WAY SOUTH OF HIGHWAY 99W

WHEREAS, that portion of Meinecke Road south of Highway 99W within the City of Sherwood is a public right of way over which the City maintains jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the City has received petitions from abutting and affected property owners in the area of this right of way requesting it be vacated; and

WHEREAS, based upon preliminary review by staff, Council has determined that there appears to be no reason why the petitions should not be allowed; and

WHEREAS, ORS 271.100 requires that Council schedule a public hearing to consider the petitions, and ORS 271.110 requires specific notice be given for such hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1:</u> The Council hereby establishes November 11, 2003 at 7:00 p.m. at the Sherwood Police Facility, 20495 SW Borchers Road, as the date, time, and location of a public hearing to consider the vacation of Meinecke Road south of Highway 99W. Said right of way is depicted on the drawings attached hereto as Exhibits A, B, and C.

Section 2: The City Recorder is authorized and instructed to provide notice complying with ORS 271.110 for said hearing.

Section 3: This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
