

Resolution 2004-012

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MURRAY, SMITH & ASSOCIATES FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A WATER SYSTEM MASTER PLAN AND THE WATER CONSERVATION AND MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the Project is contained in the city's Capital Improvement Plan;

WHEREAS, city staff utilized a consultant selection process for this project meeting the requirements of the city and state contract rules;

WHEREAS, the firm was selected through this process to develop the master plans;

WHEREAS, the anticipated design cost of this project is \$151,600; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer recommends a design contingency of 20% (\$30,400) to cover unanticipated development costs.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Murray, Smith & Associates for development of the Water System Master Plan and Water Conservation and Management Plan project for an amount not exceeding \$182,000.00.

Section 2: This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
