

EXHIBIT 1
Council Goals for Calendar Year 2004

1. Staff should discuss Sherwood's growth goals with the LCDC if it is felt that Metro is ignoring us.
2. Council would like to see a copy of the Archer posted to our Web Site.
3. Council would like to have their pictures be the first link that a citizen can use to send an E-mail to that particular Council Member.
4. Council would like to follow the School Districts Model of Key Communicators with a Web Version.
5. Council discussed posting the Archer in either the Coffee Shop window or the City Hall window.
6. Staff will check with TVF&R to discuss their responses to our growth projections.
7. Staff will review AMR's (ambulance) response goals for the City.
8. Terry will present an I-5 update at an upcoming council work session.
9. Chief Middleton will make a brief presentation at an upcoming council work session. This will become an annual presentation from Police Chief to Council.
10. Council wants to get the streets moving as soon as possible this year. They would also like to see signage up quickly and would like staff to use the Garragus site as a temporary Parking lot.
11. Staff will bring sales criteria for City Buildings to be sold, to Council. Council will review them and these criteria will become the basis for selling our surplus building stock in the next 2 years.
12. Council would like an Economic Impact Plan created and proposed to Council.
13. Council reviewed the Project planning document in the Packet and asked for an indicator to be included that would let the reader know the Project Managers estimate of % completion, compared to % complete for dollars spent. Staff will meet with Councilor Durrell and Weislogel to review reporting possibilities.
14. Follow up with Golf Course committee members letting them know that due to property costs council will not be pursuing the Golf Course as a high priority project any longer.
15. Discussion was had on a possible water line from Wilsonville to Sherwood for irrigation water to help relieve demand for City water.
16. Councilor Grant will follow up with FOOT to discuss the status of their proposed changes to the Old Town design standards.
17. Staff will contact the Y to get a monthly status on their budget and membership statistics included in the Council Packet.
