



Resolution 2004-054

A RESOLUTION TO INCREASE FUNDING FOR THE SHERWOOD SENIOR CENTER CLASSROOM ADDITION PROJECT BY \$5000.

WHEREAS, in 2003 Washington County notified the City of Sherwood that they had been awarded a Community Development Block Grant for the classroom addition at the Sherwood Senior Center; and

WHEREAS, the initial projected cost for the project was \$123,200 and the Community Development Block Grant was to provide \$106,200 worth of funding. The remainder of the project was to be funded by the Senior Center Inc. and the City of Sherwood; and

WHEREAS, the bids came back higher than expected and the total project cost is now \$192,106; and

WHEREAS, a request will be made to the Community Development Block Grant Advisory Committee for an additional \$63,906; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood sees the value in this project and wants to show support for this project by pledging an additional \$5,000 towards the project.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:
